CHAPTER 317
HOUSE BILL 2131

AN ACT

ESTABLISHING THE LICENSE PLATE STANDARDIZATION STUDY COMMITTEE.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. License plate standardization study committee;
3 membership; duties; report; delayed repeal

4 A. The license plate standardization study committee is established
5 consisting of the following members:

6 1. Two members of the senate who are appointed by the president of
7 the senate and who are members of different political parties. The
8 president of the senate shall designate one of these members to serve as
9 cochairperson of the committee.

10 2. Two members of the house of representatives who are appointed by
11 the speaker of the house of representatives and who are members of
12 different political parties. The speaker of the house of representatives
13 shall designate one of these members to serve as cochairperson of the
14 committee.

15 3. One sheriff in this state who is appointed by the governor.

16 4. One member who represents a police association in this state and
17 who is appointed by the governor.

18 5. The director of the department of public safety or the
19 director's designee.

20 6. The director of the department of transportation or the
21 director's designee.

22 7. Three members who represent organizations that have a special
23 license plate that is issued pursuant to title 28, chapter 7, article 12,
24 Arizona Revised Statutes. The governor shall appoint these members.

25 B. Appointed members serve at the pleasure of the person who made
26 the appointment.

27 C. Committee members are not eligible to receive compensation, but
28 members appointed by the governor are eligible for reimbursement of
29 expenses under title 38, chapter 4, article 2, Arizona Revised Statutes.

30 D. The committee shall:

31 1. Study whether there is a need for special license plate
32 standardization in this state and possible options for special license
33 plate redesign.

34 2. On or before December 15, 2021, submit a report regarding the
35 committee's activities and recommendations for administrative or
36 legislative action to the governor, the president of the senate and the
37 speaker of the house of representatives and provide a copy of this report
38 to the secretary of state.

39 E. This section is repealed from and after September 30, 2022.
